

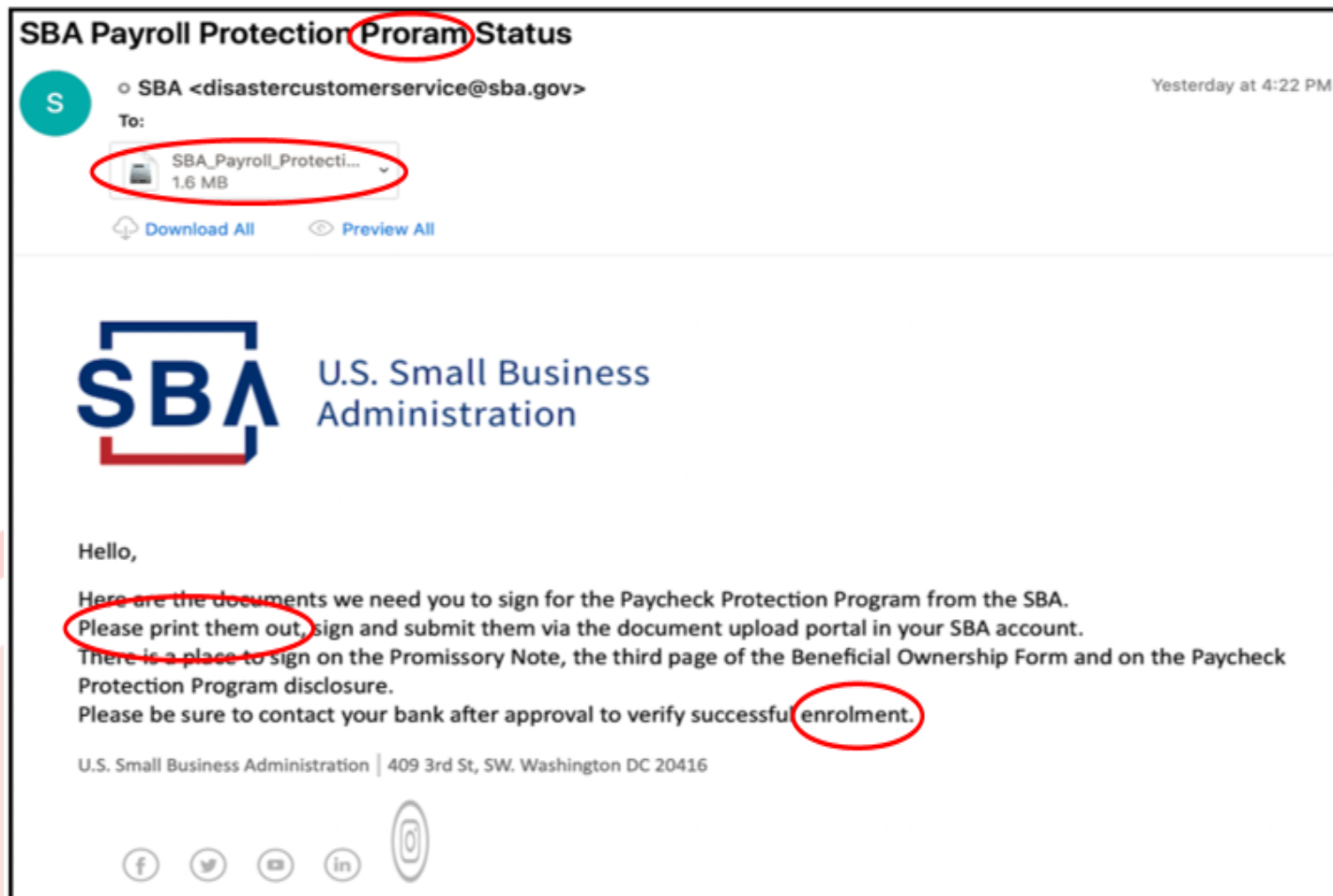


Alert: SBA Paycheck Protection Program Scam

The following is a screenshot of an active phishing attack and is intended to raise awareness to this specific attack and ones similar to it. The Michigan Cyber Command Center (MC3) confirmed this is a malicious email as the attachment in the email contained a remote access trojan and information stealing malware.

In the attack shown below there are several red flags that strongly suggest it is a phishing email:

- In the Subject line, the word “Program” is spelled incorrectly as “Proram”
- The attachment in the email is a “.img” file, suggesting it is a copy of a disk, CD, DVD, or other disk type, not a printable document.
- The email is asking you to open the attachment by stating “Please print them out”
- In the last sentence, the word “enrollment” is spelled incorrectly as “enrolment”
